Kids Arcade re-commenced this year for term 1. We have been having a lot of fun with different activities including obstacle courses, making our own dessert pizzas, playing games and




drawing. Our group is very excited to be back and have enjoyed sharing stories of their holidays and re-connecting with each other. They are also enthusiastic
