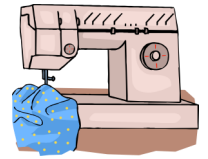

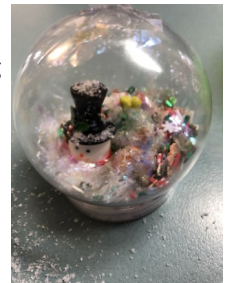
2024 FOOD AND TOY DRIVE

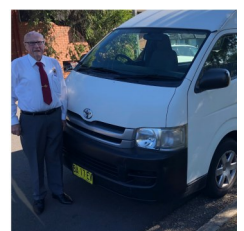
CHRISTMAS SNOW GLOBE WORKSHOP

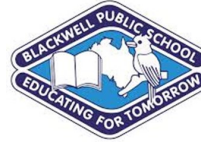
