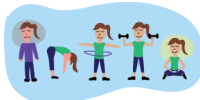

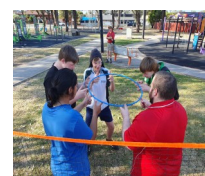
GULYANGARRI

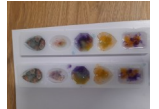
SENIORS EVENT
